Report of the Jury of London 2022

The jury of London 2022 has completed judging and is pleased to present this report.

The jury has judged a total of 545 exhibits - with a total of 47,696 pages in the frames and 318 literature exhibits, of which 38 were digital literature exhibits. The jury members have found that the quality of exhibits shown here has been of an exceptionally high standard. We have awarded 93 Large Gold Medals and 184 Gold Medals. We are also pleased to see that many exhibits have made significant improvements since they were shown in previous exhibitions.

11 exhibits were transferred to a different exhibition class to ensure they achieved a better award. Unfortunately, 63 exhibits did not arrive, but 30 exhibits were shown as photocopies. 7 were out of competition, and therefore a total of 70 exhibits could not be judged.

The Jury would like to thank the London 2022 Organising Committee and volunteers, the FIP Consultant and national commissioners for their efficiency and hard work - under the unusual circumstances created by the Corona virus. We are grateful for all exhibitors bringing these wonderful exhibits, which creates interest in our wonderful hobby.

Finally, we would like to thank the London 2022 exhibition organisers for their hospitality and the fine facilities and support provided for the jury.
