ACTIVITY REPORT OF THE FIP COMMISSION FOR TRADITIONAL PHILATELY JANUARY 1 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022

The Bureau and Commission Meetings

2022 was a difficult year for philatelic activity in some countries due to the pandemic. Despite the pandemic, the Commission met on 7 August in Jakarta during Indonesia 2022 World Stamp Exhibition. A new Chairman and Secretary was elected. The new Bureau met by email on 17 August 2022 and the agenda including the revised guidelines for judging criteria in the Traditional Philately Class, re-vamping of the FIP Traditional Philately website, delegates' communication and activity report. A new Bureau member was co-opted into the Bureau on 25 August 2022 in accordance with FIP Statutes 42.4. The composition of the Traditional Philately Bureau currently is as follows:-

Website

The Bureau Secretary acting as webmaster revamped the FIP Traditional Philately Commission sub-website of <u>www.f-i-p.ch</u> with regular updates as they are required.

The Commission's website (https://traditionalphilately.f-i-p.ch) recorded 58 visitors during the period August 2022 till 31 December 2022 according to Matomo Analytics. Aside from Hong Kong where the webmaster is based, highest number of visits came from P.R. China, Singapore, Argentina, Bangladesh, Egypt, Japan, Malaysia, Finland and New Zealand.

Seminars:

The Commission held no seminars in 2022. A qualifying seminar for Traditional Philately jurors has been planned for IBRA World Stamp Exhibition, Essen in May 2023.

The Commission Statistics:

We have recorded and published on the FIP website 87 member federations represented in our Commission. There were five delegate changes: Bangladesh (Morshed Harsan), Portugal (Rui Matos Alves), Switzerland (Fritz Aebi), U.A.E. (Omar Mohammad Ahmad) and Vietnam (Luu, Van Luong).

The following 18 FIP member Federations do not have delegates appointed:-

Brunei, Byelorussia, Cuba, Ecuador, Georgia, Guatemala, Honduras, Indonesia, Iraq, Ireland, DPR Korea, Macau, Malaysia, Malta, Mongolia, Montenegro, Slovakia and Ukraine.

Delegates' Reports:

The Commission Secretary sent a standard reply form to all delegates on 21 January 2023 and the deadline of reply was 26 February 2023. The delegates were asked to reply to their regional representative as well as the Secretary.

11 out of 87 delegates (FIAF 2, FEPA 4 and FIAP 5) sent activity report from their country before the deadline, other delegates failed to reply the Commission's Bureau members and Secretary. Sweden sent an apology for not receiving the activity report request due to communication problem. We are grateful to those delegates who complied with our request.

Hong Kong

Seminars: None held due to pandemic restrictions. Monthly Zoom meeting on youtube with some Traditional Philately topics regarding Hong Kong philately.

Exhibitions: No national stamp exhibition was held due to pandemic restrictions.

The Association of New Zealand Judges held a two-day meeting. One new Traditional Philately juror served his apprenticeship at national stamp exhibition.
