



Minutes of the FIP Traditional Philately Commission Meeting & Elections

Macao 2026 WSE, Venetian Hotel, Room 3, Monday, 29 June 9:00 -11:00

Commission Secretary Andrew Cheung opened the meeting at 9:00hr and welcomed the 33 delegates and observers at the meeting. FIP Coordinator for Traditional Philately Commission Richard Tan made introductory remark thanking everyone for coming to the meeting.

1. The following Bureau members were present at the meeting namely, Andrew Cheung and Prakit Foongvanich with apologies from the Chairman Koichi Sato.

2. The Secretary had compiled a list of delegates, alternate delegates and proxies. The commission recorded 72 delegates from 88 FIP members, 15 delegates attended in person, 6 proxies and 9 alternate delegates. Total 30 votes, the 25% quorum was achieved.

3. The candidate for FIAP Bureau member, Sdiann NG was present at the Commission meeting with Lars Jorgensen and Roberto Cravero being unable to attend with apologies.

4. The election was conducted by FIP Coordinator Richard Tan according to the regulations with voting carried out in the sequence of Chairman, Secretary and 3 Bureau members including the announcement of the votes. Only 27 voting slips were distributed because some delegates had left before the election.
